

Instruction Triangular shawl

MEASUREMENTS

Width (at widest point) x Length (approx.): 65 x 170 cm (25½ x 67 in)

MATERIALS

Rico Creative Cotton Dégradé

or

Rico Creative Cotton Dégradé Super 6

or

Rico Creative Cotton Dégradé Print

200 g

1 pair 4 mm (UK 8 – USA 6) Rico knitting needles

TENSION

20 sts and 33 rows to 10 cm, 4 in over pattern on 4 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

INSTRUCTION

Please note: Weigh yarn before starting.

Using 4 mm needles and thumb method cast on 6 sts.

1st Row. P6.

2nd Row. K6.

3rd Row. P5, pick up loop between last and next st, purl into back of this loop (this will now be referred to as m1p), p1. 7 sts.

4th Row. K7.

5th Row. K6, pick up loop between last and next st, knit into back of this loop (this will now be referred to as m1k), k1. 8 sts.

6th Row. P8.

7th Row. K7, m1k, k1. 9 sts.

8th Row. P9.

9th Row. P7, k1, m1k, k1. 10 sts.

10th Row. P3, k7.

11th Row. P7, k2, m1p, p1. 11 sts.

12th Row. K2, p2, k7.

13th Row. K10, m1k, k1. 12 sts.
14th Row. P12.
15th Row. K11, m1k, k1. 13 sts.
16th Row. P13.
17th Row. P7, k2, p3, m1p, p1. 14 sts.
18th Row. K5, p2, k7.
19th Row. P7, k2, p4, m1p, p1. 15 sts.
20th Row. K6, p2, k7.
21st Row. Knit to last st, m1k, k1. 16 sts.
22nd Row. Purl.
23rd Row. Knit to last st, m1k, k1. 17 sts.
24th Row. Purl.
25th Row. P7, k2, p7, m1k, k1. 18 sts.
26th Row. (P2, k7) twice.
27th Row. P7, k2, p7, k1, m1k, p1. 19 sts.
28th Row. K1, (p2, k7) twice.
29th Row. Knit to last st, m1k, k1. 20 sts.
30th Row. Purl.
31st Row. Knit to last st, m1k, k1. 21 sts.
32nd Row. Purl.

Proceed as follows:-

1st Row. *P7, k2, rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, m1p, p1. 22 sts.
2nd Row. K4, *p2, k7, rep from * to end.
3rd Row. *P7, k2, rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, m1p, p1. 23 sts.
4th Row. K5, *p2, k7, rep from * to end.
5th Row. Knit to last st, m1k, k1. 24 sts.
6th Row. Purl.
7th Row. Knit to last st, m1k, k1. 25 sts.
8th Row. Purl.

From 1st to 8th row sets position of patt with increases.

Cont in patt increasing as set on every rs row until half the yarn has been used, ending with a ws row and working inc sts in patt.

Proceed as follows:-

Next row. Patt to last 3 sts, patt2tog, patt 1.

Last row sets decreases.

Cont in patt decreasing as set on every rs row until 6 sts remain.

Next Row. Patt.

Cast off in patt.

TO COMPLETE

Cover with clean, damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and care instructions.
