HOME DECORATION WITH SOFTNESS

Create your own funny frog pillow
with our fluffy Pompon yarn!



Frog cushion cover

Measurements
32 x 45 cm (12½ in x 17¼ in)

Materials

- Rico Pompon
- Shade Green (024) 200g
- Wool remnants for embroidery in Black
- 1 pair 3.5 mm (UK 9 - USA 4) Rico knitting needles
- 100 g wadding

Abbreviations

- approx · approximately
- beg · beginning
- cm · centimetres
- g · grammes
- in · inches
- k · knit
- k2tog · knit 2 sts together
- rem · remain(ing)
- rs · right side
- sl1 · slip 1 st
- pssso · pass slipped stitch over

Tension

10 sts and 10 rows to 10 cm (4 in) over garter stitch on 3.5 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Check your tension - if fewer stitches use thinner needles, if more stitches use thicker needles. It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment.

Notes

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, times or rows are worked for this size.

After casting off one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow.

IMPORTANT – To ensure accuracy only Rico yarns should be used. No responsibility will be taken for the result of using any other yarns.

Cushion cover (make 2)

The cushion cover is worked with pom-pom yarn in garter stitch, knit sts only. Always work 2 sts between pompoms, holding the pompoms between thumb and middle finger to steady them. K1 before the first and after the last pom-pom of each row. After casting off pull yarn tail through last st.

Using 3.5 mm needles and thumb method cast on 12 sts (with 6 pompoms).

Rows 1 - 6. Knit to end, cast on 2 sts.

24 sts.

Rows 7 - 8. Knit.

Rows 9 - 10. Knit to end, cast on 2 sts.

28 sts.

Rows 11 - 12. Knit.

Rows 13 - 14. Knit to end, cast on 2 sts.

32 sts.

Rows 15 - 16. Knit.

Rows 17 - 18. Knit to end, cast on 2 sts. 36 sts.

Rows 19 - 31. Knit.

Rows 32. Sl1, k2tog, pssso, knit to end. 34 sts.

Rows 33 - 34. Knit.

Rows 35. Sl1, k2tog, pssso, knit to end. 32 sts.

Rows 36 - 39. Knit.

Rows 40. Sl1, k2tog, pssso, knit to end. 30 sts.

Row 41. Knit.

Row 42. K7, k2tog, turn, leaving rem 21 sts unworked on the needle or a stitch holder. 8 sts.

Rows 43 - 44. Knit.

Rows 45. Sl1, k2tog, pssso, knit to end. 6 sts.

Row 46 - 48. Knit.

Cast off rem 6 sts.

With rs facing re-join yarn to 21 sts left on the needle.

Row 1. K2tog, k6, k2tog, turn, leaving rem 11 sts unworked on the needle.

Cast off rem 8 sts.

With rs facing re-join yarn to 11 sts left on the needle.

Row 1. K2tog, knit to end. 10 sts.

Row 2. Sl1, k2tog, pssso, knit to end. 8 sts.

Rows 3 - 4. Knit.

Row 5 - 6. Sl1, k2tog, pssso, knit to end. 4 sts

Rows 7. Knit.

Cast off.

To make up

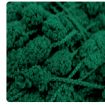
Weave in any loose threads. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave until dry. Embroider frog face on front of cushion cover as illustrated with black wool remnant. With rs together, close 3 side seams, leaving bottom seam open. Turn right side out, insert wadding and close remaining seam. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

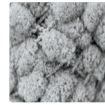
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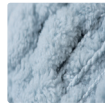
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
