# TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk Shade 001 (white) 25 g Shade 002 (cream) 25 g Shade 029 (wine red) 25 g Shade 056 (nougat) 25 g Shade 056 (silver grey) 25 g Shade 064 (mustard) 25 g Shade 060 (slate) yarn remnants for embroidery Shade 011 (pink) yarn remnants for embroidery 3 mm Ricorumi hook Rico toy stuffing Rico stitch markers

# TENSION

20 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm

## LEGS, BODY AND HEAD

Work from bottom up and fill with stuffing as you go along. FIRST LEG

In silver grey, working into magic ring, 7 dc. Continue working in a spiral. Rnd 1: (2 dc into next st) 7 times. 14 sts. Rnds 2 – 4: 14 dc. Change yarn. Rnd 5 – 7: In cream, 14 dc. SI st into next dc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

# SECOND LEG

In silver grey, working into magic ring, 7 dc. Continue working in a spiral. Rnd 1: (2 dc into next st) 7 times. 14 sts. Rnds 2 – 4: 14 dc. Change yarn. Rnd 5 – 7: In cream, 14 dc. Do not fasten off, 4 ch. **BODY** Rnd 8: 1 dc in same place as sl st of 1st Leg.

Set stitch marker, 13 dc, (1 dc in next ch) 4 times, 14 dc round second leg, 4 dc in other side of chain. 36 dc. Rnd 9: (5 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 42 sts. Bnd 10: 42 dc Rnd 11: (6 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 48 sts. Rnds 12 - 23: 48 dc. Rnd 24: (6 dc, dc2tog) 6 times. 42 sts. Rnds 25 - 26: 42 dc. Rnd 27: (5 dc, dc2tog) 6 times. 36 sts. Rnds 28 - 30: 36 dc. Rnd 31: (4 dc, dc2tog) 6 times. 30 sts. Rnds 32 - 42: 30 dc. Rnd 43: (3 dc, dc2tog) 6 times. 24 sts. Rnd 44: (2 dc, dc2tog) 6 times. 18 sts. Rnd 45: (1 dc, dc2tog) 6 times. 12 sts. Rnd 46: (dc2tog) 6 times. 6 sts. Fasten off leaving a long tail. Thread through

remaining 6 sts, pull tight and weave in tail.

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#### ARM (MAKE 2)

Lightly fill with stuffing as you go along. In silver grey, working into magic ring, 6 dc. Continue working in a spiral. Rnd 1: (2 dc into next st) 6 times. 12 sts. Rnds 2 – 4: 12 dc. Change yarn. Rnd 5 – 14: In cream, 12 dc. Lay flat and close opening with 1 ch, 6 dc through both layers. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

## EAR (MAKE 2)

Do not fill with stuffing. In cream, working into magic ring, 6 dc. Continue working in a spiral. Rnd 1: (2 dc into next st) 6 times. 12 sts. Rnds 2 – 4: 12 dc. Lay flat and close opening with 1 ch, 6 dc through both layers. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

## SNOUT

In silver grey, working into magic ring, 6 dc. Continue working in a spiral. Rnd 1: (2 dc into next st) 6 times. 12 sts. Rnd 2: 12 dc. 1 sl st into next st. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

#### TAIL

Do not fill with stuffing. In cream, working into magic ring, 6 dc. Continue working in a spiral. Rnd 1: 6 dc. Rnd 2: (1 dc, 2 dc into next st) 3 times. 9 sts. Rnd 3: 9 dc. Rnd 4: (2 dc, 2 dc into next st) 3 times. 12 sts. Rnd 5: 12 dc. Fold in half and close opening with 1 ch, 6 dc through both layers. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

#### TO MAKE UP

Use long tails to attach pieces to each other. Attach Arms to Body, below rnd 27, 8 sts apart. Fill Snout with stuffing and sew to Head between rnd 35 – 39. Fold Ears in half and sew to Head below rnd 43, 10 sts apart. Attach Tail to back of Body, below rnd 16. Embroider eyes, cheeks and nose as illustrated.

#### GLOVE (MAKE 2)

In wine red, working into magic ring, 8 dc. Continue working in a spiral. Rnd 1: (2 dc into next st) 8 times. 16 sts. Rnd 2 – 4: 16 dc. Rnd 5: 1 pc5, 15 dc. 16 sts. Rnd 6 – 7: 16 dc. Change yarn. Rnd 8: In white 16 dc. Rnd 9: 16 tr. 1 sl st into next st. Break yarn and fasten off.

## HAT

In wine red, working into magic ring, 6 dc.

Continue working in a spiral. Rnd 1: 6 dc. Rnd 2: (1 dc, 2 dc into next st) 3 times. 9 sts. Rnds 3 - 4: 9 dc. Rnd 5: (2 dc. 2 dc into next st) 3 times. 12 sts. Rnds 6 - 7: 12 dc. Rnd 8: (3 dc, 2 dc into next st) 3 times. 15 sts. Rnds 9 - 10: 15 dc. Rnd 11: (4 dc, 2 dc into next st) 3 times. 18 sts. Rnds 12 - 13: 18 dc. Rnd 14: (5 dc, 2 dc into next st) 3 times. 21 sts. Rnds 15 - 16: 15 dc. Rnd 17: (6 dc, 2 dc into next st) 3 times. 24 sts. Rnds 18 - 19: 24 dc. Rnd 20: (3 dc, 2 dc into next st) 6 times. 30 sts. Rnd 21: 5 dc, 4 ch, miss 4 dc, 10 dc, 4 ch, miss 4 dc, 7 dc. 30 sts. Rnds 22 - 23: 30 dc. Change yarn. Rnd 24: In white, 30 dc. Rnd 25: 30 tr. 1 sl st into next st. Break yarn and fasten off. Weave in ends.

## SCARF

Do not cut yarn when changing colours but carry it inside the cylinder to avoid re-attaching. Work in the following stripe sequence: 5 rnds wine red, 5 rnds white. Work the stripe sequence 7 times in total, then 5 rnds in wine red.

In wine red make 12 ch, close to a rnd with a sl st in first ch, 11 dc. Continue working in a spiral. Rnds 1 – 74 . 12 dc.

Break yarn and fasten off. Weave in ends. Fold scarf flat. Using the tails and an embroidery needle close top and bottom seam with a few sts. Weave in ends.

#### TO MAKE UP

Using strands of yarn in mustard knot tassels to top and bottom as illustrated.

### RUCKSACK

In nougat make 15 ch + 1 t-ch, turn Rnd 1: 2 dc into 2nd ch from hook, 12 dc, 4 dc into next ch, turn to work down other side of chain, 12 dc, 2 dc into next ch. 32 sts. Cont working in a spiral. Rnd 2: 32 dc. Rnds 3 - 7: 3 ch, 1 tr in st at base of 3-ch, 31 tr = 32 sts. Rnd 8: 1 ch. 1 dc in st at base of ch. 31 dc. 32 sts. Rnd 9: 1 dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 3 dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 4 dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 3 dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 3 dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 3 dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 4 dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 4 dc = 32 sts. Rnd 10: 32 dc. Rnd 1: 32 sl st. Break yarn and fasten off.

#### STRAPS

Re-attach yarn in nougat to bottom right corner of rucksack with a sl st in rnd 2. Make 30 ch, attach yarn with a sl st at the top between 2 holes, ch 30, attach with a sl st to bottom left corner on rnd 2. Break yarn and fasten off.

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**CORD** In mustard make 80 ch. Fasten off.

# TO MAKE UP

Fold sides over to make a triangle. Thread cord through the holes in rnd 9. Tie a bow with the ends.

# ABBREVIATIONS

ch – chain cont - continue dc - double crochet (UK) dec2tog - double crochet 2 sts together (decrease) pc5 – popcorn stitch (Work 5 treble crochet (tr) stitches into the same stitch. Drop the loop from your hook. Insert your hook from front to back under the top 2 loops of the first treble crochet of the group. Grab the dropped loop with your hook and pull it through the stitch. rem – remaining rnd – round rs – right side sl st – slip stitch st(s) - stitch(es) t-ch - turning chain tr – treble crochet (UK) [] - work stitches in brackets for the specified number of times





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
