Ricorumi dk

A: Shade 033 (light blue) 25 g

B: Shade 017 (lilac) 25 g

C: Shade 005 (vanilla) 25 g

D: Shade 046 (light green) 25 g

E: Shade 011 (pink) 25 g

3 mm Rico hook

## ABBREVIATIONS (BRITISH TERMINOLOGY)

approx.	approximately
ch	chain
dc	double crochet
dc2tog	double crochet 2 sts together
dtr	double treble crochet
rnd	round
sl st	slip stitch
st(s)	stitch(es)
tr	treble crochet

## EGG WARMER

In light blue or lilac, 2 ch.

Rnd 1: 6 dc in 2nd ch from hook. 6 sts.

Rnd 2: 2 dc into next st, 6 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: [2 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 24 sts.

Rnd 5: 24 dc.

Rnd 6: [3 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 30 sts.

Rnd 7: 30 dc.

Rnd 8: [4 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 36 sts.

Rnds 9 – 14: 36 dc.

Change yarn.

Rnd 15: In vanilla or light green, 36 dc.

Fasten off and break yarn, weave in ends.

## FLOWER

**(MAKE 1 IN LILAC, 2 IN VANILLA, 2 IN PINK)**

Ch 4.

Rnd 1: In 4th ch from hook work; tr2tog, 3 ch,

sl st, [3 ch, tr2tog, 3 ch, sl st] 3 times. 5 petals.

Fasten off and break yarn leaving a long thread to sew flower onto egg warmer.

## LEAF (MAKE 4, 2 FOR EACH EGGWARMER)

In light green 6 ch.

Rnd 1: 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, 1 htr, 3 tr into

next st, 1 htr, 1 dc, 2 ch, working in underside of

ch, 1 dc, 1 htr, 3 tr into next st, 1 htr, 1 dc, join

with sl st to first st.

Fasten off and break yarn, leaving a long thread to sew leaf onto egg warmer.

Sew flowers and leaves onto egg warmers as seen on the picture. Using vanilla, lilac or pink to embroider French knots for the flower centres.

Weave in ends.
