

CORRECTION FOR PATTERN

Model 5 Cardigan *



Measurements

S/M(L/XL)

Materials

Rico Creative Chic-Unique
Shade 10 (Retro) 600 g

Needles

1 6 mm (UK 4 – USA 10) 80 cm Rico circular knitting needle
Rico stitch markers
3 Rico buttons, 2,2 cm in diameter

Tension

16 sts and 22 rows to 10 cm (4 in) measured over stocking stitch on 6 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Note: Back and Fronts are knitted sideways, starting at the side edge.

Back

Using 6 mm needles and thumb method cast on 73 [78] sts.
1st row (rs). Knit.
2nd row. K6, p65 [70], k1.
These 2 rows set the sts, 1 edge st, 65 [70] sts in st st (stocking stitch) and 7 sts in g-st (garter stitch) for lower border.
Cont as now set, shaping shoulder by inc 1 st

at beg of 8th and every foll 8th row to 78 [83] sts.** Work 1 row. Set marker for neck edge.
Cont straight until work measures 45 [49] cm (17¾ in) ending with a ws row. Set 2nd marker for neck edge. Now shape other shoulder by dec 1 st at beg of next and every foll 8th row to 73 [78] sts. Work 9 more rows and cast off.

Left front

Work as given for Back to **
Cont straight until work measures 25 [27] cm (9¾ in) ending with a ws row.
Shape V-neck
Cast off 7 sts at beg of next and foll alt row. 64 [69] sts.
Work 1 row.
Cast off 6 sts at beg of next and 2 foll alt rows. 46 [51] sts.
Work 1 row.
Cast off rem 46 [51] sts.

Right front

Using 6 mm needles and thumb method cast on 73 [78] sts.
1st row (rs). Knit
2nd row. K1, p65 [70], k6.
These 2 rows set the sts, 7 sts in g-st (garter stitch) for lower border, 65 [70] sts in st st (stocking stitch) and 1 edge st.
Cont as now set, shaping shoulder by inc 1 st at end of 10th and every foll 8th row to 78 [83] sts.
Cont straight until work measures 25 [27] cm (9¾ in) ending with a rs row.
Shape V-neck
Cast off 7 sts at beg of next and foll alt row. 64 [69] sts.
Work 1 row.
Cast off 6 sts at beg of next and 2 foll alt rows. 46 [51] sts.
Cast off rem 46 sts.

Sleeves (Both alike)

Using 6 mm needles and thumb method cast on 30 sts.
1st row (rs). *K1, p1; rep from * to end.
This row forms 1x1 rib.
Work in rib until work measures 7 cm (2¾ in)

ending with a ws row.
Next row. Knit.
Next row. Purl.
These 2 rows form st-st.
Cont in st-st, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 3rd and every foll 5th row to 60 [62] sts. 60 [62] sts.
Cont straight until Sleeve measures 50 cm (19¾ in) ending with a ws row. Cast off all sts.

Front and neck band

Join shoulder seams to markers, leaving 25 cm (10 in) neck opening.
With rs facing and using 6 mm needles, starting at row-end edge of right Front, pick up and knit 45 [55] sts up right front opening edge to beg of front slope shaping, 32 sts up right front slope, 26 sts from back neck to beg of left front opening, 32 sts down left front slope and 45 [55] sts down left front opening. 180 [200] sts.
Work in g-st as given for Back for 7 rows, ending with a ws row.
Next row. K5, [cast off 1 st, k11] 3x (button holes), knit to end.
Next row. Knit, replace each cast-off st with yrn.
Work 7 more rows, ending with a ws row.
Cast off.

To make up

Place a markers 23 cm (9 in) down from shoulder seam on Back and Fronts to mark armholes. Sew in sleeves between markers. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons. Pin out cardigan to the measurements given. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
